

(c) if not, what are the reasons therefor and what steps Government propose to take to ensure due representation to the cooperative sector for fair distribution of coal and to stop malpractices by traders?

THE MINISTER OF ENERGY (SHRI P. RAMACHANDRAN): (a) The Delhi Administration issue retail coal licences in different areas, keeping in view the population of the area. Normally, they issue one coal licence for 1000 house-holds.

(b) There are six cooperative stores holding retail coal licences.

(c) The Delhi Administration give preference to the cooperative sector over private applicants, whenever they apply for retail coal licence.

Correcting the reply given on the 7th December, 1978 to Unstarred Question 1046 regarding Industry Minister's tour during October, 1978

THE PRIME MINISTER (SHRI MORARJI DESAI): While replying to part (a) of the Unstarred Question No. 1046 for 7th December, 1978, regarding Industry Minister's tours during October, 1978, I had stated that he was out of Delhi in October, 1978 for 27 days. The correct position is that the Minister was out of the Capital only on 23 days and not 27 days as mentioned by me earlier. (*Interruptions*). I regret the discrepancy which crept into the earlier reply.
