The details of the existing capacity of each IIM along with increase in intake and the introduction of the new programmes proposed for the academic year 2005-2006 are given in the Statement (see below).

(d) and (e) The proposed expansion is to meet the growing demands of the nation's managerial manpower development. There will be no cost to the Government for the introduction of the new programmes in respect of IIM Ahmedabad, IIM Bangalore and IIM Calcutta. Necessary funds will be provided by the Government for the above said purpose in respect of IIM Lucknow, IIM Indore and IIM Kozhikode.
