(a) whether it is a fact that there are no irrigation facilities in the hill areas of Uttarakhand in Uttar Pradesh where holdings are small and scattered and the method of farming unscientific; and

(b) if so, what steps Government propose to take provide irrigation facilities in such areas?

Problems of the Khandsari industry

(b) if so, what steps Government propose to take to provide relief to the industry?

THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF AGRICULTURE AND IRRIGATION (SHRI BHANU PRATAP SINGH): (a) Yes, Sir.

(b) The reliefs asked for by them are mainly in regard to the reduction of excise duty and exemption from local taxes like the purchase tax. These were examined in detail and it was seen that excise duty on khandsari sugar is already quite low. Hence, since of most of the controls on the khandsari are in the hands of the State Governments, they are being consulted in regard to the further exemption or relief from the local taxes.

Admission to M.B.B.S. course under the Central Government quota in the medical colleges at Cuttack and Agra

(b) whether it is also fact that there were several other eligible persons among the applications; and

(c) if so, what are the steps being taken for selecting the applicants in part (a) above in preference to the eligible applicants?
