Creation oi employment through 10+2+3 pattern of education

THE MINISTER OF EDUCATION, SOCIAL WELFARE AND CULTURE (DR. PRATAP CHANDRA CHUN-DER): (a) and (b) The Education Ministers' Conference held on July 13-15 resolved that the structure of school education comprise of elementary, secondary and higher secondary stages of 12 years duration. The stage of higher secondary of two years duration is designed to provide both for academic and vocational education. The pattern of school education will not by itself create employment opportunities but the programme of vocational education which is an essential ingredient of the pattern is deisgned to make the students either more employable or engage in self-employment.
