Ag a result the police had to resort to firing to bring the situation under control. In all 37 cases have been registered and 412 persons were arrested. A total of 40 rounds were fired and 423 tea,- gas sheils were used. Three persons including one police nonstable were killed wMe another person died following cardiac arrest. •83 persons including 56 police personnel received injuries.

Not less than 75 per cent of the vacancies in Grade IV of Indian Economic Service/Indian Statistical Service are filled by direct recruitment Not more than 25 per cent of the vacancies in Grade IV are filled by selection from among officers serving in offices under the Government in economic/statistical posts recognised for this purpose by the Controlling Authority, i_n consultation with the Union Public Service Commission.

(b) and (c) Keeping i_n view the nature of duties and responsibilities attached to these Services, the direct recruitment quota to Grade IV is not considered to b_e unreasonably high. The Third Central Pay Commission w hich examined the structure and other aspects of the Services has also not made any observation regarding direct recruitment quota in Grade IV. However, steps are being taken to prepare Select List_s fo_r promotion of feeder posts holders to Grad_e IV of the Indian Economic/Statistical Service to the extent vacancies are available for trvfc-,n in the promotion quota.

(d) The Third Central Pay Commission has not made ^{an}y recommendation to constitute a Cla_{Ss} II non-gazetted Service in respect of I'ndian Economic Service an^ India]! Statistical Service.
