

(c) whether it is a fact that the allocation for vocational education and Training Scheme has been considerably reduced during the last ten years; and

(d) if so, the reasons therefor?

**THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF HUMAN RESOURCE DEVELOPMENT (SHRI MD. ALI ASHRAF FATMI):** (a) to (d) The budget allocation under the scheme of Vocationalisation of Secondary Education at +2 level for VIIIth and IXth Five Year Plans was Rs. 410 crores and 100 crores respectively. The Plan allocation for Xth Five Year Plan is Rs. 350 crores. The Plan allocation during the IXth Plan was reduced considering the proposal for transferring the scheme under State Sector. In view of the revision of the existing scheme to formulate a new scheme of Vocational Education and Training, the Annual Plan allocations during Xth Plan have also been reduced. The details of courses offered under the scheme are given in the published document on the scheme.

(c) the number of the craftsmen and workers belonging to minorities getting benefited from Industrial Training Institute and polytechnics situated in these districts?

**THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF HUMAN RESOURCE DEVELOPMENT (SHRI MD. ALI ASHRAF FATMI):** (a) to (c) No Sir. There is no such scheme so question do not arise. However it may be mentioned that under a scheme of the Labour Ministry 309 ITI's are functioning in the 41 districts of the country having majority of educationally backward minorities. Similarly 77 Community Polytechnics are functioning in these districts. Details are given in the Statement.
