The price of tonned milk was increased with effect from May 2, 1978 but was still lower than its cost of production. The price of double tonned milk was slightly increased from May 2, 1978 but was reduced to the original level from May 14, 1978. Thus in the case of double tonned milk there has effectively been no increase of price.

It is estimated that consequent upon price revision of tonned milk, the overall loss would decide to about Rs. 3.50 crores in the current year as compared to Rs. 6.83 crores in the last year.

The Management Committee of the D.M.S. is taking various steps to improve the operational efficiency and reduce the loss of DMS and further improvement may become evident in the next financial year:

(i) a major renovation and repair programme to revitalise plant and machinery nearly 20 years old has *been* undertaken.

Employment bureaus at the University Campuses

(a) and (b) University Employment Information and Guidance Bureaus have been functioning since 1957-58 as an integral part of the National Employment Service. Their main activities are: providing vocational guidance to students, collection and dissemination of occupational information including avenues for selfemployment among students, registration of students for providing part-time/vacation employment etc. Such Bureaus are functioning in 66 universities at present.
