(b) The National Programme for Prevention of Visual Impairment and Control of Blindness aims at—

(i) intensifying educational efforts-, on eye health care through media of mass communication avid extension education methods;

(ii) extending ey_e car_e serv through mobile units to restore sight and relieve eye ailments by adopting an 'eye-camp' approach; and

(iii) establishing a permanent infrastructure for community oriented eye health care.

(c) 13 lakh eye operations were performed during the last two years of which 6 lakh were performed in 1976-77 and 7 lakh in 1977-78. About 8 lakh operations ai'e estimated to be: performed during this year.
