PATIL): (a) and (b) In pursuance of the overall objective of providing banking facilities in the hither to unbanked areas, banks have been advised to ensure that latest by June 1978, each Community Development Block in the country is provided with at least one commercial bank branch According to available information, there were 29 Community Development Blocks in the Northern Region as at the end of September 1977 which did 'not have a commercial bank branch. Of these 6 were in Hima-chai Pradesh, 12 in Jam«nu and Kashmir and 11 in Rajasthan.
