(c) Foreign items used by Doordarshan comprise news coverages of international events, documentaries etc, puchased by Doordarshan outright or on royalty basis, films on art, culture, Education and Science received from foreign missions in India and materials received from foreign countries under protocols cultural agreements on reciprocal basis. Selection of the programmes is done keeping in view their suitability for Doordarshan. The overall percentage of utilisation of foreign films by Doordarshan does not generally exceed 3,5.
