

to the State Governments are released for undertaking various activities relating to Socio-economic and educational development of Primitive Tribal Groups.

Under the Scheme, the State Governments of Orissa and other Voluntary Organizations working for the development of Primitive Tribal Groups in Orissa have so far been released Rs. 711.88 lakhs since inception of the scheme. The releases so made to the State Governments also includes Rs. 8.50 lakhs for undertaking Base Line Survey to assess the socio-economic conditions and the immediate requirements for development of Primitive Tribal Groups. All State Governments including Orissa have been requested to prepare comprehensive Conservation-cum-Development plan for the Primitive Tribal Groups. It has been decided to provide insurance coverage to one earning member from each PTG family during Tenth Five Year Plan under Janshree Bima Yojana of Life Insurance Corporation. All the State Governments having Primitive Tribal Groups have been provided funds for insurance coverage of one lakh earning member during 2004-05 and for the purpose Rs. 5.00 Crores have been released to the State Governments. The State Government of Orissa has been released Rs. 12.50 lakhs for providing insurance coverage to 2500 heads of families during 2004-05.

Achievement of literacy targets

†*636. SHRIMATI MAYA SINGH: Will the Minister of HUMAN RESOURCE DEVELOPMENT be pleased to state:

(a) whether it is a fact that Government have issued guidelines to the State Governments that they should achieve a target of seventy five per cent literacy rate in their respective States during the next two years;

(b) if so, whether Government propose to provide any grants to achieve the said target; and

(c) if so, the details thereof?

THE MINISTER OF HUMAN RESOURCE DEVELOPMENT (SHRI ARJUN SINGH): (a) Universalisation of elementary education and eradication of adult illiteracy form the two-pronged strategy for improving the literacy rate of the country. The goal of the National Literacy Mission is to achieve a literacy rate of 75 per cent for the country by 2007. All States have been asked to implement literacy programmes in order to achieve the above goal.

(b) and (c) During the Tenth Plan, an allocation of Rs. 1250 crores has been made for the National Literacy Mission and Rs. 17,000 crores for the Sarva Shiksha Abhiyan. Details of State-wise grants released during the last three years under the Sarva Shiksha Abhiyan and the schemes of National Literacy Mission are enclosed at Statement-I and II.
