THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF SOCIAL JUSTICE AND EMPOWERMENT (SHRIMATI SUBBULAKSHMI JAGDEESAN): (a) to (e) The Government is providing loans for pursuing general professional/technical education at graduate and post graduate level. OBC students from families living below double the poverty line are eligible to apply to the respective State Channelising Agencies (SCAs). NBCFDC does not invite applications directly.
