Khariff Crops damaged due to Rain Water

(a) whether it is a fact that every year Delhi and the adjoining districts of other States are flooded by rain water resulting in enormous damage to Khariff crops and loss to farmers; and

(b) if so, what steps Government propose to take to prevent this annual loss?

THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF AGRICULTURE AND IRRIGATION (SHRI BHANU PRATAP SINGH): (a) and (b) During

years of heavy rainfall, some areas in Delhi and adjoining districts of Haryana and Rajasthan are affected by floods resulting in damage to crops etc. The flood situation this year became serious on account of extremely heavy rainfall and unprecedented floods in the Sahibi river. To discuss the problem of floods in Delhi, Haryana and Rajasthan due to Sahibi Nadi and find solution therefore, an inter-State meeting of the Chief Ministers of Rajasthan and Haryana and Lt. Governor of Delhi was convened by the Prime Minister on August 10, 1977. It was decided in the meeting that a Master Plan be prepared urgently for utilisation of the Sahibi Waters for irrigation and ground water recharge to the extent possible and for safe disposal of surplus waters into Yamuna. Such a Master Plan is being prepared by the Central Water Commission in consultation with the Chief Engineers of the States of Haryana, Rajasthan and Delhi. An outline plan is expected to be ready by end of December, 1977. This may *inter alia* include construction of a storage reservoir on river Sahibi at Ajmeripura in Rajasthan mainly for irrigation and Masani in Haryana mainly for flood moderation, improvement of Najafgarh drain in Delhi to its optimum possible capacity, and proposals for construction of small storage, ground water recharge, soil conservation, additional drains etc.

THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF HEALTH AND FAMILY WELFARE (SHRI JAGDAMBI PRASAD YADAV): (a) No. However, the Government have decided to integrate Tuberculosis, Leprosy and Cholera with General Health Services in the multi-purpose districts.

(b) The possible benefits are:

- (i) Integrated approach.
- (ii) More economical and effective programme.
- (iii) Greater rapport with the people.
- (iv) Better coverage of population.
- (v) Better health care service.
- (vi) Better supervision etc.

(c) The proposed integrated programme is based on pilot studies conducted within the country.
