THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF COMMERCE, CIVIL SUPPLIES AND COOPERATION (SHRI ARIF BEG): (a) and (b) M.M.T.C. has concluded long term agreements with South Korea envisaging export of 16.6 million tonnes of iron ore to that country spread over a period from 1973-74 to 1985-86.
