SHRI SAWAISINGH SISODIA; Will the Minister of DEFENCE be pleased to state the service prospects of the released Emergency Commissioned Officers who have been absorbed as Administrative Officers in the National Cadet Corps and have completed more than five years of service?

THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF DEFENCE (SHRI SHER SINGH): Several released Emergency Commissioned officers have been granted Commissions as whole time NCC officers. They are appointed on a temporary basis for a period of three years and extensions of service are given to them, provided their performance is satisfactory,—for three years at a time upto the age of 55.

The Evaluation Committee on NCC headed by Dr. G. S. Mahajani had recommended that this category of officers should be gradually replaced by regular service officers. However, this has not been found possible due to the continued shortage of regular service officers.

As several of these officers have rendered fairly long and continuous service in the NCC, a proposal to provide security of tenure, to those of them who have a good record of service, is being examined.
