- (b) what is the number of applications received for these flats;
- (c) whether any panel or waiting list is maintained for allotment of flats lying unallotted in various DDA colonies; and
- (d) if so, by when the remaining persons on the waiting list are expected to be allotted flats in the various DDA colonies?

THE MINISTER OF WORKS AND HOUSING AND SUPPLY AND REHABILITATION (SHRI SIKANDAR BAKHT): (a) Yes, Sir.

- (b) 1150.
- (c) For each scheme, a waiting list, equal to 25 per cent of the total number of flats is maintained.
- (d) Allotment of surrendred/cancelled flats in respect of allotments made prior to 17th August 1977 is in progress. The Delhi Development Authority expects to comlete the process of allotments in these cases by the end of December 1977.

Compilation of Bengali terminology for scientific, technical and medical literature

- 419. SHRI SHRIKANT VERMA: Will the Minister of EDUCATION, SOCIAL WELFARE AND CULTURE be pleased to state:
- (a) whether it is a fact that the Central Government propose to give assistance to the West Bengal Government for compiling Bengali terminology for scientific, technical and medical literature; and
- (b) if so, what are the details in this regard?

THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF EDUCATION, SOCIAL WELFARE AND CULTURE (SHRIMTAI RENUKA DEVI BARKATAKI): (a) and (b) No request for financial assistance has so far been

received from the Government of West Bengal for compiling Bengali terminology for scientific, technical and medical literature.

Setting up of Industrial Housing Estates in States

THE MINISTER OF WORKS AND HOUSING AND SUPPLY AND REHABILITATION (SHRI SIKANDAR BAKHT): (a) No, Sir.

Setting up of an open University

- 421. SHRI JANARDHANA REDDY: Will the Minister of EDUCATION, SOCIAL WELFARE AND CULTURE be pleased to refer to the answer to Starred Question 190 given in the Rajya Sabha on the 17th March, 1976 and state:
- (a) whether Government have since decided to set up an open University;
- (b) if so, what are the details thereof and by when this University will start functioning; and
- (c) if the answer to part (a) above be in the negative, what are the reasons therefor?

THE MINISTER OF EDUCATION, SOCIAL WELFARE AND CULTURE (DR. PRATAP CHANDRA CHUNDER): (a) to (c) Government have decided not to proceed with the proposal during the Fifth Five-Year Plan.
