Will the Minister of WORKS AND HOUSING AND SUPPLY AND REHABILITATION be pleased to state:

(a) whether Government have received any representation from the rehabilitated inhabitants of Balapura Village No. 2, P.O. Nahargarh Tehsil in District Kishanganj, Rajasthan, regarding the hardships suffered by them as the lands allotted to them are full of forests and are of hard soil which do not permit any cultivation being done there;

(b) if so, what are the details thereof;

(c) whether it is a fact that the financial assistance for the construction of residential quarters which

was being given to them has also been stopped and the work on water supply system has not yet been completed; and

(d) if so, what action Government have taken or propose to take in this regard?

THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF WORKS AND HOUSING AND SUPPLY AND REHABILITATION (SHRI RAM KINKAR): (a) and (b) Yes, Sir. The representations were on alleged defective land, stoppage of cash doles and rations, slow progress in construction of houses, and on provision of drinking water, of dispensary and of primary school. The State Government have reported that the allotted land is fertile; cash doles and rations are being given; houses have been constructed and within next two months they will be completed; drinking water has been provided by deepening the wells, besides mobile dispensaries, medical officer has been posted at a close-by village so that adequate medical facilities can be available; and educational facilities have been provided by appointing teachers and also by constructing the primary school which will be completed soon.
