However, available studies are felt to he deficient in certain respects. Accordingly Government have decided to study the effects of tractors and combine harvesters on employment output and costs afresh and for this purpose set up a committee headed by Shri B. Sivaraman. Till trie riiicfirigs of the committee become available Government propose to follow a policy of selective mechanisation.

THE MINISTER OF WORKS AND HOUSING AND SUPPLY AND RE-HABILITATION (SHRI SIKANDAR BAKHT): (a)

(b) The question of conferment of tenancy rights/ownership rights in respect of lands allotted to the refugees from Pak-occupied Kashmir and Displaced Persons from Chhamb is primarily a matter for the Jammu and Kashmir State to decide. In terms of Jammu and Kashmir Agrarian Reforms (Amendment) Act, 1978 displaced persons cultivating evacuees lands personally would in respect thereof be deemed to be occupancy tenants and recorded as such. They would have the right to transfer their right of occupancy tenancy by sale, mortgage or gift subject to the provisions of the Alienation of Land Act and the provisions of Section 60 of the Jammu and Kashmir Tenancy Act, would not apply to such transfer.

THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF HEALTH AND FAMILY WELFARE (SHRI JAG-DAMBI PRASAD YADAV): (a) and (b) The Government of India has no such information.

(c) and (d) The States ar_e free to purchase the required quantity of oral-polio vaccine (Salk-vaccine) from the Haffkine Bio-Parmaceutical Corporation, Bombay. This Corporation imports polio vaccine in bulk and
