Irrigation facilities in Bihar

5098. SHRI MOTIUR RAHMAN: Will the Minister of WATER RESOURCES be pleased to state:

- (a) the details of irrigation facilities in Bihar;
- (b) the districts in Bihar which are deficient in irrigation facilities;
- (c) the steps being taken to ensure adequate irrigation facilities in Motihari and Champaran districts; and

(d) the allocation of funds made in the current financial year for the said purpose?

THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF WATER RESOURCES (SHRI JAI PRAKASH NARAYAN YADAV): (a) The total irrigation potential created in Bihar is about 7.55 million hectare through major and medium irrigation projects and minor (both surface and ground water) irrigation schemes.

(b) Government of Bihar has identified Nalanda, Nawada, Vaishali, Munger, Sekhpura, Lakhisarai, Darbhanga and Samastipur district which are deficient in irrigation facilities.

(c) and (d) To ensure adequate irrigation facilities in Motihari and Chamoaran District, the Eastern Gandak Canal project at an estimated cost of Rs. 294 crore has been approved. The project has been included in the Rashtriya Sam Vikas Yojna for 100% Central funding and a sum of Rs. 50 crore has been released to Government of Bihar in 2004-05.
