1252. SHRI KRISHNARAO NARA-YAN DHULAP: Will the Minister of INDUSTRY be pleased to state:

(a) what varieties of cotton were imported during the last three years; and

(b) what are the prices paid for the different varieties of imported cotton $a_n d$ what prices were prevelant for the same varieties of cotton in the country during the said period?

THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF INDUSTRY (KUMARI ABHA MAITI): (a) and <b) The information is being collected and will be laid on the Table of the House.

Posting of Extension Officers (Industries) in each block

1253. SHRI V. P. MUNUSAMY: Will the Minister of INDUSTRY be •pleased to state:

(a) what is the number ₀f officers who were trained as Block Level Extension Officers (Industries) in the country from 1958 to 1976, a'nd how many training centres were in the country in 1963 to train these officers; and

(b) whether there is any proposal under Government's consideration to post an Extension Officer (Industries) in each block to promote the deve lopment of small scale and village in dustries?

THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF INDUSTRY (KUMARI ABHA MAITI): (a) Total number of BLEO (Ind.) trained by SIDO from 1955-56 to 1967-63 is 4353 year-wise figures are not available. The programme was discontinued from 1967-68 in the training centres under SIDO.

There were 1 4 training centres during the above mentioned period under SIDO in the country, *viz.* Delhi, Bombay, Madras and Calcutta.

(b) Under the DIC set up some State Governments have provided for an extension officer at the Block Level.

Professionalisation of large industrial houses

1254. SHRI N. K. P. SALVE: Will the Minister of INDUSTRY be pleased to state:

(a) whether Government propose to convene a three-tier dialogue with the industry to chalk out future plans for professio'nalisation of large industrial houses and to find solution to problems of concentration of economic power; and
