**Grants to Various Autonomous Bodies by  
the Ministry of Health and Family  
Welfare**

1490. SHRI R. R. MORARKA : Will the Minister of HEALTH AND FAMILY WELFARE be pleased to state:

(a) whether Government propose to lay a statement on the Table of the House showing the grants made to various autonomous bodies together with the amount sanctioned to each during the Fourth Five Year Plan period and also during the three years of the Fifth Five Year Plan period; and

(b) what is the purpose of making these grants to these bodies ?

THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF HEALTH AND FAMILY WELFARE (SHRI JAGDAMBI PRASAD YADAV) : (a) No, Sir.

(b) The grants are given for research, construction of buildings, purchase of equipment and for meeting maintenance expenditures of the institutions concerned as also for promoting health and Family Welfare Programme.

**Cost of Medical Education in India**

(a) whether Government have undertaken any study of the cost of medical education in India;

(b) if so, whether the study has been completed and Government propose to lay a copy of the report of the study on the Table of the House;

(c) what is the *per capita* cost worked out in respect of a Government medical college, a Government aided medical college and a private medical college; and

(d) if the answer to part (b) above be in the negative, by when the study is likely to be completed?

WELFARE (SHRI JAGDAMBI PRASAD YADAV): (a) and (b) A preliminary study was conducted by the Central Bureau of Health Intelligence of the Government of India in June, 1977 and March /April, 1978 in respect of the Medical College, Simla, and the Jawaharlal Institute of Postgraduate Medical Education and Research, Pondicherry, respectively.

(c) According to this study, the cost works out to Rs. 92,000/- and Rs. 1,35,000/- at Simla and Pondicherry respectively based on the expenditure incurred by the Colleges in 1975-76. No study was conducted in respect of Government, aided medical colleges and private medical colleges.

**Mausoleum for the Late President

(d) when the construction work on the mausoleum is likely to start and what is the estimated expenditure on it?

Shri H. Rehman, a Consulting Architect has been appointed to prepare the design of the 'Mazar' of the late President Shri Fakhruddin Ali Ahmed. Preliminary drawings of the 'Mazar' has been received and accepted. Detailed drawings of the design are awaited. There is no proposal to construct a mausoleum or to invite any other designs.

(d) A railing around the 'Mazar' has been provided. The foundation work is likely to start shortly. Some specifications are still under finalisation.
