

Press comments regarding the Hindustan Organic Chemical's proposal to manufacture Para Nitro Phenol (PNP); and

THE MINISTER OF PETROLEUM, CHEMICALS AND FERTILIZERS (SHRI H. N. BAHUGUNA): (a) and (b) M/s. Hindustan Organic Chemicals Limited are putting up a plant of 500 tonnes/annum of Para Nitro Phenol (PNP) based on indigenous process. This will not affect the units in the small scale sector as demand estimates indicate that there is sufficient scope for the existing small scale units as well as the Hindustan Organic Chemicals' plant.

THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF RAILWAYS (SHRI SHEO NARAIN): The list of new railway lines proposed to be taken up for construction in the backward areas of Maharashtra during the Sixth Plan has not yet been finalised. A new policy regarding construction of railway lines in backward areas of the country is under consideration of the Government at present. Pending finalisation of the new policy, construction of a new broad gauge line from Apta to Roha (62 Kms.) has been included in the Budget for 1978-79.
