Production of jute in the country

- (a) whether it is a fact that production of raw jute in the country has declined during the last ten years posing a danger to the export perfornance of the jute manufacturers ir* ihe country; and

THE MINISTER OF AGRICUL-TURE AND IRRIGATION (SHRI SURJIT SINGH BARNALA): (a) No. Sir. Although the production of jute in the country has fluctuated in recent years, the overall rate of growth has shown an increasing trend.

(b) Question does not arise. However, a comprehensive Centrally Sponsored Scheme of Intensive Jute District Programme has been launched by Government of India to increase-jute production in the country since 1972-73.
