THE MINISTER OF INDUSTRY (SHRI GEORGE FERNANDES): (a) and (b) The proposal for the manufacture of passenger cars in the public sector was considered by the Government in 1972 and it was decided at that time not to proceed with the implementation of the project. Government are presently considering various proposals including the participation of the public sector for upgradation of the passenger car industry.

(a) whether it is a fact that a sum of Rs. 30 crores was sanctioned to the Punjab Government by the Central Government for setting up an Electronics Complex at Mohali in Ropar District;

(b) whether it is also a fact that the complex is being drastically pruned and the investment is being reduced to Rs. 4 crores and part of the project is being transferred to Tamil Nadu and other States; and

(c) if so, what are the reasons therefor?

THE PRIME MINISTER (SHRI MORARJI R. DESAI): (a) No, Sir. The Department of Electronics is itself setting up a Central Public Sector Company, called M/s. Semiconductor Complex Limited, Mohali near Chandigarh at a total cost of Rs. 15.7 crores.

(b) No, Sir. There has been no change in the investment originally planned and approved for this project. The entire project is being implemented at Mohali.
