- (ii) Failure of persons other than Railway Staff—22.
- (iii) Failure of equipment-29.
- (iv) Accidental-8.
- (v) Causes not yet finalised-41.
- (c) As failure of human element is the largest single factor responsible for accidents, Safety Organisations set up on the Railways have been engaged in inculcating safety consciousness amongst the staff connected with the running of trains and in ensuring that the staff do not violate safety rules or indulge in short cut methods. Thorough inquiries are held into all accidents and appropriate remedial measures are taken.

Poor Quality of food served in Rajdhani Express Trains

- 42. SHRI SHRIKANT VERMA: Will the Minister of RAILWAYS be pleased to state:
- (a) whether Government have received complaints about the poor quality of food served in Rajdhani Express Trains running between Delhi-Bombay and Delhi-Calcutta; and

(a) During the year 1976-77, there was no complaint about poor quality of food served in Rajdhani Express Trains

(b) With a view to improve the quality of food, Railways have taken a number of steps like setting up of "Base-Kitchens" on important routes to supply 'ready to serve' meals.

Other steps such as adoption of modern culinary techniques, provision of modern kitchen gadgets and equipments, purchase of good quality food articles and other ingredients from the standard suppliers, etc., have resulted in further improvement in the quality of food.
