THE MINISTER OF AGRICULTURE AND IRRIGATION (SHRI PRAKASH SINGH BADAL) : (a) Yes, Sir. A report to this effect was published in the Times of India dated the 25th April, 1977.

(b) The report of the ICAR Inquiry Committee headed by Shri P. B. Gajendragadkar was examined in depth by the Govt. of India with the assistance of a groups of Ministers consisting of late Shri Fakhruddin Ali Ahmed, then Minister of Agriculture, Shri C. Subramaniam, Prof. Ram Niwas S. Nurul Hasan and Shri recommendations of Mirdha. The the Committee have already been implemented with such modifications as considered necessary by the Government of India. However, if any specific problems in this regard are brought to the notice of Government, these can be examined.
