The Centre would render whatever assistance is necessary. However since dialysis is a very costly facility, involving Rs. 6 lakhs towards capital cost and about Rs. 3 lakhs as annual recurring cost, State Governments would have to provide these sums within the overall priorities in the Health sector.
