THE PRIME MINISTER (SHRI MORARJI R. DESAI): (a) No, Sir.

## DTC. Bus service in the rural areas of Delhi

- 579. SHRI SYED AHMAD HASHMI: Will the PRIME MINISTER be pleased to state:
- (a) what steps Government propose to take to streamline the D.T.C. bus services to the rural areas of Delhi, particularly covering Narela/Lampur border and other adjoining villages;
- (b) whether it is a fact that D.T.C. bus service in the rural areas of Delhi has deteriorated during the last six months;
- (c) whether it is also a fact that the shuttle services of D.T.C. from Lampur Border/Narela to Azadpur have been discontinued for the last six months, if so, what are the reasons therefor; and
- (d) what steps Government have taken to improve the D.T.C. bus service on these routes?
- THE PRIME MINISTER (SHRI MORARJI R. DESAI): (a), (b) and (d) Due to depletions in the fleet and in the absence of replenishments for over a year, there has been some paucity of services in certain sectors in these areas. Steps are being taken to fill the gaps as expeditiously as feasible when it is expected there would be some improvements.
- (c) A route between Narela and Azadpur was introduced, specifically for operation of bus services by ex-servicemen under DTC's control. After operating the services for about a year, the ex-servicemen withdrew their buses from this route in August, 1976, on the ground that the services were uneconomical.
