

(b) As a result of these measures, consumer prices have fallen by Rs. 300/- in the case of 12/14" TV sets and Rs. 700/- in the case of 19/20" TV sets.

#### Seniority of Assistants

\*83. SHRI SYED AHMAD HASHMI: Will the PRIME MINISTER be pleased to refer to the answer to Unstarred Question 565 given in the Rajya Sabha on the 25th March, 1976 and state:

(a) whether it is a fact that various Ministries have made Assistants, appointed after the 1st October, 1962, senior to those Assistants whose names were already appearing in the combined civil list as on the 1st October, 1962 irrespective of the fact that such Assistants were confirmed much after the Assistants who were listed in the combined seniority list as on 1st October, 1962; and

(b) if so, what remedial measures Government propose to take in the matter?

THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE DEPARTMENT OF PERSONNEL AND ADMINISTRATIVE REFORMS (SHRI OM MEHTA) : (a) The coined all Secretariat Civil List of Assistants comprised not only confirmed Assistants, but also those holding temporary posts in a regular manner and on an *ad hoc* basis. In accordance with the provisions of the C.S.S. Rules, 1962, the direct recruits who are appointed after 1-10-1962, against permanent vacancies, and share those vacancies with the promoted officers on a 50:50 basis, rank junior to the Assistants confirmed before 1-10-1962. Such a direct recruit however, would rank senior to an Assistant who was only officiating before 1-10-1962 and is given a substantive vacancy in his turn after yielding the preceding substantive vacancy to the direct recruit under the quota system.

(b) It has been decided to take up the matter with the Union Public Service Commission so that cases of acute hardship are redressed.

#### Recession in industry

\*84. SHRI SUBRAMANIAN SWAMY : Will the Minister of INDUSTRY be pleased to state:

(a) whether Government are aware of

the statement made by Shri Arunachalam Present of HCCI that the industries suffering from a worse recession which is more widespread than what was in 1967-00; and

(b) if so, what is Government's reaction thereto?

THE MINISTER OF INDUSTRY (SHRI T. A. PAI) : (a) Yes, Sir. Government's attention has been drawn to the remarks made by Shri Arunachalam at the 49th annual session of the Federation of Indian Chambers of Commerce and Industry that "while it is true that the recession is not a pervasive phenomenon, I would like to think, that it is more widespread than the sectoral recession we experienced in 1967-68."

(b) The general index of industrial production available for January-April 1976 has shown a rate of growth of nearly 11.5 per cent over the corresponding period of the previous year. The data regarding industrial production trends in the recent months do not support the above view.

प्रेस एजेंसी संगम के बारे में गुट-निरक्षेप देश के मंत्री स्तरीय सम्मेलन के निर्णय ये थे: सूचना माध्यमों के संबंध में सहयोग के विषय पर सम्मेलन को घोषणा-पत्र जारी करना, गुट-निरक्षेप देशों के प्रेस एजेंसी संगम का गठन और संगम को चालू करने के लिए समन्वय समिति की स्थापना; जन सम्पर्क के विभिन्न माध्यमों के क्षेत्र में गुट निरक्षेप देशों के बीच आगे सहयोग के लिए एक कार्रवाई कार्यक्रम तैयार करना; गुट निरक्षेप देशों के बीच दूर-संचार सुविधाओं का अध्ययन करने के लिए विशेषज्ञों की एक समिति गठित करना और गुट निरक्षेप देशों के देश या सरकार के प्रमुखों के आगामी शिखर सम्मेलन के घोषणा-पत्र में शामिल करने के लिए सूचना माध्यमों पर पैराग्राफों का प्रारूप तैयार करना।

**Statement**

The decisions of the Ministerial Conference of Non-aligned Countries on the Press Agencies Pool were : the issue of a Conference Declaration on the subject of co-operation in respect of information media; the Constitution of a Pool of Press Agencies of Non-aligned Countries and the setting up of a Coordination Committee to make the Pool operational; the adoption of an Action Programme for further cooperation among non-aligned countries in the field of various mass media; the setting up of a Committee of Experts to study telecommunication facilities among non-aligned countries; and formulation of draft paragraphs on information media for inclusion in the Declaration of the forthcoming Summit Conference of Heads of State or Government of Non-aligned Countries.

2. A Coordination Committee was appointed to make the pool operational as soon as possible.

3. The pool is founded on the principle of being a self-financing activity. Broadly, each participating news agency is entitled to transmit and to distribute news items within the frame-work of the pool and can send daily an agreed wordage to one or more distributing agencies. All distributing news agencies will provide in their daily transmissions or newscasts a mutually agreed duration of time to be devoted to distribution of news received from other participants. Each news agency will endeavour, to the full extent of its possibilities to promote utilisation of the news and information carried on by the pool, through publications, radio and television stations using its services.]

THE MINISTER OF INDUSTRY (SHRI T. A. PAT) : (a) and (b) Yes, Sir. The present budget allotment for the current year 1976-77 is Rs. 10 crores for disbursement as Subsidy for industrial units being set up in backward areas.

(c) Yes, Sir. An Official Committee had studied the subsidy scheme.

(d) A summary of the main recommendations made in the Report of the Committee headed by Sh. P. C. Nayak formerly Secretary (Industries) Govt. of Maharashtra is enclosed. These recommendations are under examination of Govt. [See Appendix XCVII, Annexure No. 25]
