

Introduction of Agriculture research service by ICAR

802. SHRI RAGHBIR SINGH GILL : Will the Minister of AGRICULTURE AND IRRIGATION be pleased to state :

(a) whether it is a fact that the Indian Council of Agricultural Research has introduced the Agricultural Research Service this year and has conducted an examination;

(b) if so, what is the number of candidates, who appeared in the examination, interviewed and selected under each branch of the Service this year;

(c) what is the number of posts that were filled under each branch of the Service;

(d) whether the Service is proposed to be a regular feature; and

(e) if so, by when the next examination is proposed to be held ?

THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF AGRICULTURE AND IRRIGATION (SHRI SHAH NAWAZ KHAN) : (a) Yes, Sir. The Indian Council of Agricultural Research has introduced the Agricultural Research Service with effect from the 1st October, 1975. Besides inducting the existing suitable employees of the Council into the Service, a competitive examination was conducted in March, 1976 for recruitment of Scientists in Grade S-1 of the Service in the scale of Rs. 700—1300. The result of the examination was announced on the 26th July, 1976.

(b) A statement giving the requisite information is attached.

(c) All the candidates who have qualified in the competitive examination are being appointed to the Service in their respective discipline.

(d) Yes, Sir.

(e) The next ARS Examination is proposed to be held in February, 1977.
