The Indian Council of Agricultural Research has introduced the Agricultural Research Service with effect from the 1st October, 1975. Besides inducting the existing suitable employees of the Council into the Service, a competitive examination was conducted in March, 1976 for recruitment of Scientists in Grade S-1 of the Service in the scale of Rs. 700-1300. The result of the examination was announced on the 26th July, 1976.

- (c) All the candidates who have qualified in the competitive examination are being appointed to the Service in their respective discipline.

- (e) The next ARS Examination is proposed to be held in February, 1977.
