Statement

The upgradation scheme covers Class III and IV categories where there was a need for easing promotional bottlenecks. Artisan cadres are, however, not included and will be dealt with by a Railway Workers Classification Tribunal which is being set up. R.P.F. staff have been dealt with separately.

The cadres reviewed include over 9 lakh posts and approximately 41,000 posts stand to be upgraded.
