Will the Minister of REVENUE AND BANKING be pleased to refer to the reply to Unstarred Question 451 given in the Rajya Sabha on the 25th May, 1976 and state:

(a) whether the relevant data in respect of Cooch-Bihar and Jalpaiguri districts of West Bengal has since been collected;

(b) if so, whether any decision has been taken by Government to set up a Regional Rural Bank in that area; and

(c) if the answer to part (b) above be in the affirmative, what are the details in this regard?

THE MINISTER OF REVENUE AND BANKING (SHRI PRANAB MUKHERJEE): (a) No, Sir; the data in respect of Cooch-Bihar and Jalpaiguri districts are yet to be received from the Reserve Bank of India.

**India's contribution to International Fund for Agricultural Development**

(a) whether Government propose to contribute to the 1 billion interna-

tional Fund for Agricultural Development;

(b) if not, what are the reasons therefor;

(c) whether India is expected to derive any benefits out of this Fund; and

(d) if so, what are the details in this regard?

THE MINISTER OF FINANCE (SHRI C. SUBRAMANIAM): (a) Yes, Sir.

(b) Does not arise.

(d) It is not possible at this stage to give details of the benefits that will flow to India from the International Fund for Agricultural Development. Its establishment will open to the developing countries including India a new multilateral source of aid for agricultural development.
