(a) the number of students in each central school in different States and in how many schools, hostel facilities have been provided to the students; and

(b) how many central schools are proposed to be opened in the year 1976-77?

THE DEPUTY MINISTER IN THE MINISTRY OF EDUCATION AND SOCIAL WELFARE AND IN THE DEPARTMENT OF CULTURE (SHRI D. P. YADAV) : (a) and (b) The Central

School at Jorhat is presently accommodated in a temporary building provided by the local Air Force authorities. As this is very close to the air field, there is some disturbance in the school on account of the noise in the air field. The Air Force authorities have now allotted a piece of land away from the air field where the construction of the school building will be sanctioned shortly. When the School shifts to the new building the noise disturbance from the air field will be overcome.
