Per capita availability of essential commodities

*233. SHRI DEORAO PATIL: Will the Minister of INDUSTRY AND CIVIL SUPPLIES be pleased to state:

(a) whether it is a fact that the per. capita availability of essential commodities had gone down during the year 1973-74 as compared to the year 1960-61; and

(b) if so, what were the reasons therefore?]

उद्योग और नागरिक पूर्ति मंत्री (श्री टी. ए. पै) : (क) और (ख) जी नहीं । आम खपत को महत्वपूर्ण आवश्यक वस्तुओं जैसे अनाज, खाने के तेल, चीनी और मिट्टी के तेल की प्रति व्यक्ति लभ्यता में तो वास्तव में बढ़ोत्तरी हुई है। वर्ष 1973-74 में वनस्पति को प्रति व्यक्ति लभ्यता स्थिर रही, किन्तु बाद में उसमें सुधार हुआ है । यह मुख्यतः सूती कपड़ा है, जिसकी प्रति व्यक्ति लभ्यता में कुछ कमी हुई है । इस कमी को कृत्रिम सूत को बड़ी लभ्यता काकी हद तक प्रतिपूर्ति कर दी गई है ।

availability of important essential commodities of mass consumption such as cereals, edible oils, sugar and kerosene has in fact gone up. The per capita availability of vanaspati in 1973-74 was constant but has improved subsequently. It is primarily cotton doth which has recorded some decline in per capita availability. This decline has been substantially compensated by increased availability of man-made fibres.]

Electrification of villages in Andhra Pradesh

Will the Minister of ENERGY be pleased to state:

(a) the number of villages in Andhra Pradesh (i) which have so far been electrified; (ii) which are yet to be electrified; and

(b) the number of schemes completed or in the process of implementation under the rural electrification scheme in the State?

THE MINISTER OF ENERGY (SHRI K. C. PANT): (a) There are 27,221 villages in Andhra Pradesh. 11,136 villages were electrified upto 31-3-1976. 16,085 villages remain to-be electrified.

(b) The Rural Electrification Corporation has sanctioned 115 schemes for Andhra Pradesh upto 31-3-1976. The schemes are phased for completion over a period ranging upto five years. All the schemes are in various stages of implementation.
