commissioned. Discharge of water from Farakka Barrage is expected to reduce, after some years, the expenditure on river dredging and permit maintenance of better draught which in turn would permit bigger and larger number of vessels to come up to Calcutta. This in turn is likely to lead

to greater traffic and increased revenue. It is, however, too early for such an impact to be felt now.
