and (b) The performance of the < orporation is reviewed from time to time. The Corporation is performing a very useful function in supplying fish at reasonable prices to the consumers at Calcutta through its retail chain.

(d) The quantity and value of fish imported from Bangladesh is as under :—

(e) The Corporation has set up 50 retail stalls in different localities in and outside Calcutta. In addition, fish is sold to consumers directly through 100 commis sion agents appointed by the Corporation in Calcutta and 14 commission agents at Karimganj. The fish is sold at these places at prices fixed by the Corporation from time to time.
