Results of the Government run schools

1290. SHRI E.M. SUDARSANA NATCHIAPPAN: Will the Minister of HUMAN RESOURCE DEVELOPMENT pleased to state:

- (a) whether it is a fact that Government run schools in different parts of the country are year after year producing very bad results in the board examinations;
 - (b) if so, the details thereof; and
- (c) what steps are being taken by Government to improve their performance?

THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF HUMAN RESOURCE DEVELOPMENT (SHRI MD. ALI ASHRAF FATMI): (a) to (c) As per information provided by Central Board of Secondary Education (CBSE) the Kendriya Vidyalayas and Jawahar Navodaya Vidalayas run by the Government are showing good results year after year. There is a gradual improvement in the examination results of Government and Government aided schools in the country affiliated to CBSE. No record is maintained centrally for the examination results of various State boards.

Budget allocation for vocational education

ALI ASHRAF FATMI): (a) As per the information furnished by the Ministry of Social Justice & Empowerment, during the year 2003-04, an amount of Rs. 381.81 lakhs has been released to various voluntary organizations for running vocational training centres for the physically handicapped persons under the scheme of Deendayal Disabled Rehabilitation.
