Participation of NGOs in Sarva Shiksha Abhiyan

1278. SHRI SHANKAR ROY CHOWDHURY: Will the Minister of HUMAN RESOURCE DEVELOPMENT be pleased to state:

- (a) whether NGO's are participating in progressing Government's "Sarva Shiksha Abhiyan";
 - (b) if so, the criteria and method for appointing such NGO's;
- (c) whether there has been inadequate publicity given to "Sarva Shiksha Abhiyan" such that NGO's are not aware of the programme;
- (d) whether there have been complaints of inordinate delays in allotment of Government funds to NGO's for this purpose; and
 - (e) if so, the details thereof?

THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF HUMAN RESOURCE DEVELOPMENT (SHRI MD. ALIASHRAF FATMI): (a) to (e) Registered NGOs of atleast 3 years standing are undertaking activities under various components of the "Sarva Shiksha Abhiyan". A Grant-in-aid Committee (GIAC) at State level, after due appraisal of the proposal and capacity of the NGO, considers and approves projects.
