THE DEPUTY MINISTER IN THE
MINISTRY OF SHIPPING AND

SINGH): (a) Notification for its constitution
was issued on 7th January, 1975.

(b) The Council held two meetings in
August and December during 1975. Another
meeting fixed for June, 1975 had to be
cancelled by the then Chairman, DTC, due to
unavoidable circumstances.

(c) DTC Advisory Council Rules provide
for holding Council's meetings once in two
months.

(d) The next meeting of the Council is
now scheduled to be held in February, 1976.
The procedure laid down for holding the
Council's meetings is being followed now.
