comparison to 400 in 2001. The number of such cases further came down to 312 in 2003.

(b) The number of cases of dowry deaths reported during 2001 -2003 are as under:

- (c) It depends on case to case.
- (d) to (f) There is no such proposal under consideration of the Government. The direct responsibility for implementing the Dowry Prohibition Act, 1961, including registration and investigation of the cases of dowry related offences, is that of State Governments.

## Clashes between para-military personnel and train passengers

- (c) Necessary instructions have been issued to educate the Force personnel to conduct themselves in  $\bf a$  civil and disciplined manner.
