(ख) तन्जानिया सरकार के अनुरोध पर हमने वहाँ समरूप से उद्योग स्थापित करने में तन्जानिया की सहायता के लिए कई भारतीय विशेषज्ञ नियुक्त किए हैं । राष्ट्रीय उद्योग विकास निगम ने, जो एक सार्वजनिक क्षेत्र परामर्शकारी फर्म है, इन परियोजनाओं के लिए सहायता प्रदान की है ; एक औद्योगिक एस्टेट, एक बिलेट कास्टिंग यूनिट, और खेती के औजार, मशीनी औजार, इस्पात शीशे की चादर और चीनी बनाने की परियोजनाएं । हमने तन्जानिया को औद्योगिक विकास के लिए 5 करोड़ रुपए का ऋण भी दिया है ।

(b) At the request of the Tanzanian Government we have deputed a number of Indian experts to assist Tanzania in identifying and setting up industries there. The National Industrial Development Corporation, a public sector consultancy firm, has provided assistance for projects such as an Industrial Estate, a Billet Casting Unit and for the manufacture of farm implements, machine tools, steel, sheet glass and sugar. We have also extended a loan to Tanzania for a sum of Rs. 5 crores for industrial development.]

#### Manufacture of plant nutrients by Hindustan Copper Ltd.

Will the Minister of STEEL AND MINES be pleased to state:

(a) whether it is a fact that Hindustan Copper Ltd. and Hindustan Zinc Ltd. have started manufacture of plant nutrients as by-products;

(b) if so, the details thereof;

(c) what is the expenditure incurred in marketing the plant nutrient products; and

(d) whether Government propose to undertake the sale of the plant nutrients through public sector agencies and co-operatives?

THE DEPUTY MINISTER IN THE MINISTRY OF STEEL AND MINES (SHRI SUKHDEV PRASAD): (a) *Hindustan Copper Limited*: Hindustan Copper Ltd. is setting up a plant for the production of about 2 lakh tonnes of Triple-Super-Phosphate. The Plant is under construction and is likely to be commissioned by March, 1975.

*Hindustan Zinc Limited*: The Hindustan Zinc Ltd., Udaipur, has been manufacturing Single Super Phosphate in its zinc smelter at Debari (near Udaipur) utilising by-product sulphuric acid. The company has also been manufacturing zinc sulphate mainly for captive consumption.

(b) *Hindustan Copper Limited*: Does not arise.
