possible measures are taken to minimize the accidents such as (i) Adequate barricading at construction sites has been provided. (ii) Proper safety signages have been provided in the project road. (iii) Effective road safety management has been developed and implemented. (iv) Adequate reflectivity as well as proper lighting has been provided.
