THE MINISTER OF SCIENCE AND (SHRI T. A. PAI): TECHNOLOGY (a) The question of reconstitution of National Committee on Science and Technology is under consideration of Government. However, with a view to maintaining continuity in the functioning of the Committee the term of the existing Committee (which expired on 24-10-74) has been extended upto 28-2-1975 (or till the reconstitution of the Committee whichever is earlier). Dr. A. Ramachandran, Secretary, DST has been appointed as the Vice-Chairman.

### Automatic Telephone Exchange at Dindigul in Tamil Nadu

THE MINISTER OF COMMUNICA-TIONS (SHRI **SHANKER** DAYAL. SHARMA): (a) No. Sir. The planning of an automatic exchange at a place depends on the total telephone demand, availability of land for an exchange building and the financial viability of the Scheme.

(b) A scheme for automatising Dindigul (where the total telephone demand on 31-3-74 was only 1286) is under examination.

## Employees on Go-Slow tactics in various R.M.S. Zones

- (a) whether it is a fact that employees in some of the RMS Zones are on go-slow tactics causing thereby inordinate delay in the delivery of mail at important Railway junctions: and
- (b) if so, what are the details thereof and what steps Government propose to take in this regard?

THE MINISTER OF COMMUNICA TIONS (DR. SHANKER DAYAL

- (b) On account of restrictions in overtime expenditure the staff in the major mail in Harvana, Punjab, Uttar Pradesh and handling offices in Calcutta resorted go-slow tactics before and during season when traffic is usually heavy.
- (c) As a result, the mails accumulated. The Postmaster-General, Calcutta appointed lower grade officials on the approved list as temporary sorters, employed short-duty sorters and permitted Over-time duty on restricted basis. Besides, supervision in the sorting offices was augmented by the deputation of officers from the Postmaster-General's office. The accumulation now been cleared.

THE DEPUTY MINISTER IN MINISTRY OF ENERGY (PROF. DHESHWAR PRASAD ): (a) The power supply position in Rajasthan has been satisfactory. However, there have been power shortages in the States of Haryana, Punjab and Uttar Pradesh.
