Will the Minister of EDUCATION, SOCIAL WELFARE AND CULTURE be pleased to state:

(a) whether it is a fact that all the vacant posts for the Centre of Advanced Study in Applied Mathematics at Calcutta University were advertised throughout the country through all the leading newspapers;

(b) whether it is also a fact that the names and qualifications of all the candidates for the post of any scholar, selected or rejected, were always submitted to the University Grants Commission by the Centre for information; and

(c) how many graduates of different universities, other than the graduates of Calcutta University, have received Masters' or Doctoral Degree or training in this Centre during the last five years?

THE MINISTER OF EDUCATION, SOCIAL WELFARE AND CULTURE (PROF. S. NURUL HASAN): (a) and (b) The Centres of Advanced Study advertise the Junior and Senior Research Fellowships and make selections on All-India basis and the names and qualifications of all the candidates who are selected as well as those who are rejected are furnished to the Commission for information. However, this information is not submitted to the Commission in respect of teaching posts. This procedure was being followed by Calcutta University also.

**Cauvery Waters**

1663. SHRI RABI RAY: Will the Minister of AGRICULTURE AND IRRIGATION be pleased to state:

(a) whether it is a fact that the Tamil Nadu Chief Minister has sought Prime Minister's intervention asking Karnataka Government to release the Cauvery waters impounded in the new Kabini reservoir to save gamba paddy crop in Tanjore district of the Tamil Nadu; and

(b) if so, what are the details thereof?

THE DEPUTY MINISTER IN THE MINISTRY OF AGRICULTURE AND IRRIGATION (SHRI KEDAR NATH SINGH): (a) and (b) The question of releasing water from the Kabini Reservoir to meet the water requirements of the Cauvery Delta was discussed with the Chief Ministers of Karnataka and Tamil Nadu at the meeting held on 28th and 29th November, 1974 at Delhi in connection with the issues relating to the Cauvery waters. It was decided that the question will be further discussed between the two State Governments at Bangalore to arrive at an amicable settlement for the release of Kabini water by Karnataka. It is understood from the Government of Karnataka that they have since released part of the water stored in the Kabini Reservoir for the Cauvery Delta.

**Naturopathy Hospital for Delhi**
