

tion Cooperatives and private dealers also held certain quantities of fertilisers in stocks, the exact value of which is not readily available.

(c) Government of India have written to the State Government to review the fertiliser distribution system existing in the State and the credit needs of the farmers and distributions. It is understood that the State Government have already introduced certain relaxations in their distribution system. The State Government have, however, intimated that the position of the off take of fertilisers has improved in the State during the past two weeks.

Delhi Education Act

1706. SHRI N. G. GORAY: Will the Minister of EDUCATION, SOCIAL WELFARE AND CULTURE be pleased to state:

(a) whether it is a fact that a number of Government aided schools in Delhi have filed a writ petition in the Delhi High Court challenging the Delhi Education Act and Rules made thereunder;

(b) if so, the names of those schools;

(c) whether these schools have suspended payment of salaries to their staff pending decision of the Court; and

(d) the steps taken by Government to ensure regular payment to the staff working in these schools?

THE DEPUTY MINISTER IN THE MINISTRY OF EDUCATION AND SOCIAL WELFARE AND IN THE DEPARTMENT OF CULTURE (SHRI D. P. YADAV): (a) Yes, Sir.

(b) A statement is attached.

(c) According to the information furnished by Delhi Administration, these schools have not suspended payment of salaries to their staff. However, they have refused to accept the procedure of payment of salaries, etc. as prescribed by the Delhi Administration in their Notification dated the 29th October, 1974.

(d) In respect of the writ petitions filed by the managements of a few schools, the Delhi High Court has directed that the cheques of the grant in-aid may now be sent as before. The Petitioner shall utilise this amount only

for payment of the salary of staff and teachers and that all payments will be duly, regularly and punctually made and the statements of such payments shall be made and furnished supported by an affidavit to the Delhi Administration latest by the 15th of each month. According to the Delhi Administration is giving grant-in-aid to these schools on the basis of the old pattern and procedure with a view to ensuring the payment of salaries to the staff.
