

### Finalisation of The Pay Scales of the Architectural Assistants

1674. SHRI MONORANJAN ROY:  
SHRI SALIL KUMAR GANGULI:

Will the Minister of WORKS AND HOUSING be pleased to state:

(a) whether it is a fact that the pay scales of Architectural Assistants of C.P. W.D. have not yet been finalised after the recommendations of the Third Pay Commission;

(b) if so, what are the reasons for delay;

(c) whether it is also a fact that the pay scales of Architectural Assistants and Assistant Supervisors of the C.P.-W.D. are the same; and

(d) if so, whether Government propose to place the Architectural Assistants in the same scale of pay as that of Sectional Officers of the C.P.W.D. in view of the duties of similar nature; and if not, what are the reasons,therefor?

THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF WORKS AND HOUSING (SHRI MOHAN DHARIA): (a) and (b) The scale of pay of Architectural Assistants (Ordinary Grade) in the CP WD is Rs. 205-280. The Third Pay Commission have recommended that half the number of posts in this scale should be placed in the scale of Rs. 425-700. and the remaining half should be placed in the scale of Rs. 330-560, provided that where the number of posts in the scale of Rs. 205-280 is less than 10 per cent of those in the scale of Rs. 150-240, all the posts in the scale of Rs. 205-280 should be placed in the higher scale of Rs. 425-700. In the CPWD, there is no post of Architectural Assistant (Ordinary Grade) at present in the scale of pay of Rs. 150-240. In view of this, the question as to whether 50 per cent of the posts of Architectural Assistants (Ordinary Grade) should be placed in the lower scale of Rs. 330-560 is under consideration, and no decision has so far been taken.

(c) and (d) There is no post of Assistant Supervisor in the CPWD. The

scale of pay of Junior Engineers (Sectional Officers) in the CPWD as recommended by the Third Pay Commission is also Rs. 425-700.

(b) if so, the details thereof and the difference between the ground floor and first floor cost;

(c) what will be the mode of recovery; and

(d) whether any agency has been set up for proper maintenance and upkeep of these quarters and to prevent violation of the terms of allotment, if not, the reasons therefor?

(a) the estimated expenditure likely to be incurred on the Jawaharlal Nehru University in the year 1974-75; and

(b) the number of students and teachers enrolled in the University at present respectively?]

**शिक्षा, समाज कल्याण और संस्कृति मंत्री (प्रो० एस० नरुल हसन) :** (क) विश्व-विद्यालय अनुदान आयोग से प्राप्त सूचना के अनुसार जवाहरलाल नेहरू विश्वविद्यालय ने 1974-75 के अपने परिशोधित प्राक्कलन व्यय में निम्नलिखित व्यवस्थाएँ की हैं :—

इसके अतिरिक्त, विश्वविद्यालय ने, स्नातकोत्तर केन्द्र, इफाल के विकास हेतु 1974-75 के लिए 17.24 लाख रुपये की व्यवस्था की है। केन्द्र के योजनेतर व्यय की जिम्मेदारी मणिपुर सरकार की है।

(ख) इस समय, विश्वविद्यालय के छात्रों तथा शिक्षकों की संख्या क्रमशः 2,241 और 230 है। इन आँकड़ों में 438 अंशकालिक छात्र तथा 14 अंशकालिक शिक्षक भी शामिल हैं।

<sup>s</sup> THE MINISTER OF EDUCATION, SOCIAL WELFARE AND CULTURE (PROF. S. NURUL HASAN): (a) According to the information received from the University Grants Commission, the Jawaharlal Nehru University has made the following provisions in its Revised Estimates of expenditure for 1974-75:—

In addition, the University has provided Rs. 17.24 lakhs for 1974-75 for the development of the Postgraduate Centre at Imphal. The non-plan expenditure for the Centre is the responsibility of the Government of Manipur.

(b) The number of students and teachers in the University is at present 2241 and 230 respectively. These figures include 438 part-time students and 14 part-time teachers.]

#### **Opening of New Universities in Maharashtra**

1677. SHRI S. W. DHABE: Will the Minister of EDUCATION, SOCIAL WELFARE AND CULTURE be pleased to state:

(a) whether it is a fact that the Maharashtra Government have proposed to the Central Government for opening of new Universities at Amraoti and at a place in Khandesh area, if so, when the proposals were sent;

(b) what decision Government have taken thereon; and

(c) what is likely to be the expenditure recurring and non-recurring, for establishing these universities?

THE MINISTER OF EDUCATION, SOCIAL WELFARE AND CULTURE (PROF. S. NURUL HASAN): (a) and (b) The Government of Maharashtra had in November 1972 submitted a proposal to the University Grants Commission for the establishment of two Universities in the State—one at Amraoti in Vidarbha region and the other in the Northern part of the Western Maharashtra region. The Commission has requested the State Government to supply necessary data and details about the proposed Universities, in the prescribed pro-forma and also copies of the reports of the two Committees appointed by it in this respect. The required information is awaited from the State Government.

(c) According to the information received from the State Government even the rough financial implications have not been worked out.
