(c) if the answer to part (b) above be in the negative, whether Government propose to issue instructions not to detain any employee for over-time work beyond the said limit, irrespective of the nature and urgency of work; if not, the reasons therefor.'

THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF FINANCE (SHRI PRANAB MUKHERJEE: (a) and (b) Existing orders provide that the overtime earnings of office staff and other staff, whose hours of work and nature of duties are comparable to those of office staff, should not exceed 1/3rd of their monthly emoluments. In special circumstances, the per-sonnel staff are allowed overtime earnings, not exceeding 50 per cent of their monthly emoluments, provided that their officers certify that they had satisfied themselves that the payment in excess of 1/3rd ceiling, but not exceeding 50 per cent, was necessary in the public interest.

(c) As detention of employees on over-time work is resorted to only in cases of urgency of work and as arrangements have necessarily to be made to meet such situations, it is not possible to issue instructions not to detain employees beyond a certain limit.
