Will the Minister of SHIPPING AND TRANSPORT be pleased to state:

(a) whether it is a fact that a large number of permits have been issued for operating mini buses within the urban areas of the Union Territory of Delhi;

(b) whether it is also a fact that by pressing into service a large number of small carrying capacity vehicles, Government have added to the traffic hazard on the main roads of the Capital;

(c) whether it is also a fact that in no other metropolitan city, mini buses are operated as part of the public transport system; and

(d) if so, what action Government propose to take to see that the mini buses are gradually withdrawn from operation in Delhi?

THE MINISTER OF SHIPPING AND TRANSPORT (SHRI KAMALAPATI TRIPATHI): (a) 176 permits have been granted for operation of mini buses in the Union Territory of Delhi.

(b) No, Sir. In fact, a large number of buses have been diverted to the Ring Road so as to reduce traffic hazards in the populated areas.

(c) Mini buses are plying in Calcutta also.
