Close and constant liaison is, therefore, being maintained with the Department of Coal in regard to the production and supply of coking coal, with the Ministry of Energy, authorities of D.V.C. and State Governments concerned to ensure maximum supply of power to the steel plants and with the Ministry of Railways to ensure satisfactory movement by Rail of essential inputs and saleables.]

**Air Chief Marshal's interview with the correspondent of 'Yayiryan'**

790. SHRI M. KADERSHAH : Will the Minister of DEFENCE be pleased to state :

(a) whether the Air Chief Marshal obtained Government's prior permission before giving a recent interview to the correspondent of 'Yayuyan' regarding effectiveness of Indian Air Force Transport planes; and

(b) if not, whether Government propose to lay down guidelines for the service officers in this regard ?

THE MINISTER OF DEFENCE (SARDAR SWARAN SINGH) : (a) No. Sir. It may, however, be added that in the interview the reference was to the IAF transport planes, Dakota and Packet having become very old and requiring retirement. The deficiencies with regard to the transport aircraft have already been mentioned in the Ministry's Annual Report for the year 1969-70.

(b) Not necessary as rules already exist on the subject.

Name of work	Approximate cost
1. Tambani Ghat Road to connect Poona with Dighi Harbour	Rs. 2.00 crores
2. Construction of a Road from Khandus to Bhimsharkar	Rs. 1.00 crores
3. Construction of a coastal Highway from Rewas to Redi	Rs. 7.00 crores

As formulation of detailed programmes for the 5th Plan is still in a preparatory stage, it is not possible at this stage to indicate the extent to which the projects referred to above will be finally included under the afore-said programme during the 5th Plan.
